Survey Visits

The field surveys to geo tag the fruit plantations have been an ongoing activity since October, 2019. A total of 1993 surveys have to be completed to determine the amount of financial help that will be given to farmers as well as check the status of plantation on each field.

2020 Target- 30 Lakh Fruit Trees in Marathwada

After the successful plantation of 11.75 lakh fruit trees in Parli Taluka this year, we have increased our target plantation and outreach activities to four districts of Marathwada- Beed, Latur, Osmanabad, and Parbhani. For 2020, our plantation goal is 30 lakh fruit trees across these four districts. Our outreach activities will now cover a total of 3,835 villages spread out in an area of 31,930 sq.km. This area of our operations is bigger than 58 countries of the world including Belgium, New Zealand, and Israel.

In Mid-December, we opened fruit registrations for Papaya farmers so the new plantation can begin in Jan/Feb. In roughly 15 days, we have received a booking of 1.82 lakh saplings from 120 farmers of Parbhani and Beed. The numbers are likely to increase manifold, once outreach activities begin across all districts in the next few weeks.

Drumstick and Beekeeping Training Programme



On December 4th, we partnered with KVK Ambajogai to conduct a training and information session on drumstick pruning, beekeeping, and water and fertilizer management.

- Shri Narendra Joshi of KVK, Ambajogai spoke on drumstick pruning methods.
- Shri Rajasaheb Hare of Agricultural Science Center, Ambajogai spoke on water and fertilizer management techniques
- Shri Atpadikar (Pune) and Shri Dinkar Patil (Chakur) spoke on beekeeping and its benefits.



The training was attended by 200 farmers who were also given information on the various grants for beekeeping that are provided by Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC).

School Bag Distribution

On behalf of an anonymous donor, Global Parli distributed school bags to 300 students of the Waghala Ashram School, Parli in conjunction with our activities to provide an enabling environment for the students to gain access to quality education.
