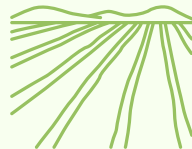

We have thus far been able to plant over 4 crore tree plantings in a span of 4 years with the aid and direction of our supporters, as well as the dedication of our numerous ground teams and especially farmers. 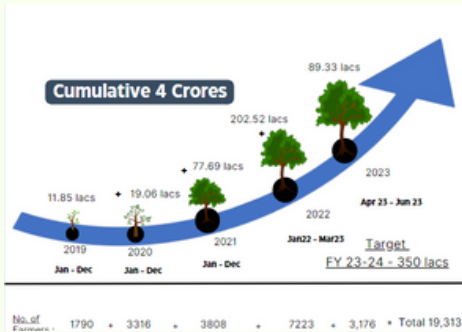

PACHORA CLUSTER SURVEY



The largest sweet lemon cluster in Jamner taluka, spanning Pachora, Soyagaon, and Vaya Singhad, has been quickly spreading. Farmers earn between 2.5 and 4 lakh rupees per acre, with wealthy farmers constructing nurseries and sourcing local trees for new plantings. Despite consistent rainfall and government-motivated Pokhra initiatives, the number of farmers in the eastern half of Jamner taluka remains poor, signalling development potential.
